Inside Peer Review: One Manuscript, From Draft to Publication

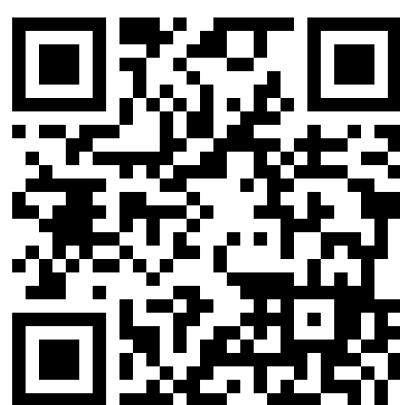
This seminar offers PhD researchers an inside view of the peer-review process by following a published management paper from its original submission through major revision to publication. Drawing on editorial decision letters, reviewers' comments, and the authors' point-by-point responses, the session explores how reviewers assess theoretical contribution, methodological rigor, and argumentative consistency, and how manuscripts evolve through successive rounds of feedback.

Combining an introduction to academic peer review with a close reading of real review correspondence, participants will examine how authors refine research questions, hypotheses, and claims in response to criticism. Particular attention will be given to the recursive nature of revision and to practical guidance on structuring effective response letters, addressing reviewers' concerns constructively, and clearly communicating changes to editors and reviewers.
